
Plindustry Trends – Oregon









The ongoing Covid19 pandemic has been disruptive to the private investigations industry.



Section 1: Aggregate PPP Loan Data

The Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) program was launched in 2020 through the CARES Act. The program allows entities to apply for low-interest private loans to cover payroll and other costs.

The industry sector that received the most PPP loans was Professional, Scientific & Technical Services. The total amount of loans received by the industry was 14,682.

The industry sector that received the most total loan amounts was Construction. This industry was awarded a total sum of 1,299.01 MM in PPP loans.

The industry sector that reported the most jobs retained was the Accommodation & Food Services Sector. The total amount of jobs reported retained in this sector was 19,6264.





Wage Trends

The data shows the average expected annual earnings for a private investigator in this state as of May 2020. The data indicates that the lowest 10% income earners make about \$42,370 in a given year while the top 90% income earners make about \$78,440.

PI Industry Projections


Licensure Trends

The data indicates that the PI industry grew by 5.99% between 2016 to 2017. This period of significant expansion was follwed by an average increase of 2.52% per annum prior to the COVID19 pandemic.

In contrast to trends in other states, the OR state PI industry does not appear to have contracted due to the ongoing COVID19 pandemic. Instead, it appears that growth has levelled off from 2020 through 2021.
